Locate a cemetery plot: The National Cemetery Administration (NCA) has launched a new interactive "Find a Cemetery". The application enables anyone to search for the final resting place of a Veteran at any of the 155 VA-managed or 119 VA-funded cemeteries. Another feature of the application is the ability to search for the closest cemetery near their zip code, with information to call the cemetery, provide directions, find burial schedule information, and leave tributes, photos, and more at the Veterans Legacy Memorial (VLM). The VLM can search with just the name or additional information (branch of service, war period of service, cemetery name/location). When found, you are directed to a website with information on the service record, an image of the grave site, an aerial image of the grave location, and information about the cemetery. You can also share tributes and historical documents (citations, newspaper articles) on this site.
